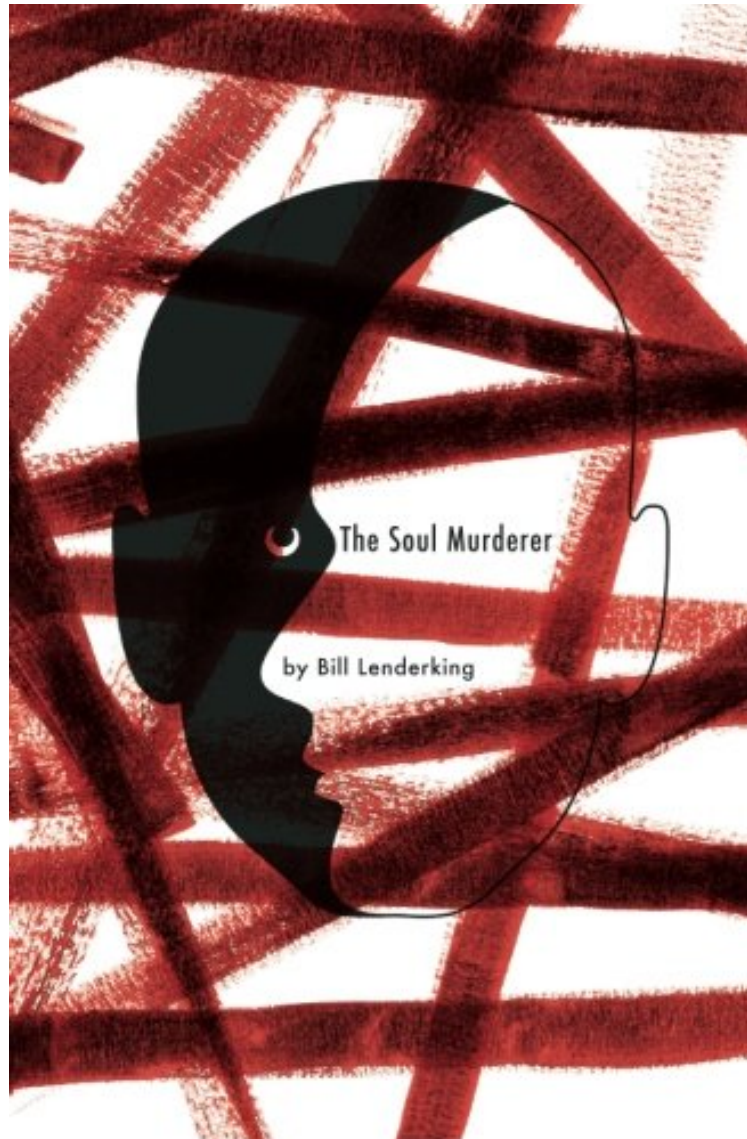

The actual place was an island of Equitorial Gunnea, then under a murderous dictator. The two man staff of Embassy had their differences, the psychological tension agravated by the local terror and heat, finally resulting in the killing of the junior officer. The Soul Murderer By Pacer This compelling novel, based on actual events, was a page-turner both for me and my wife, who found the role and contributions of a Foreign Service spouse relevant to both the story and career of the principal. Lenderking writes well, and both the historical and psychological research he did give this work of fiction the feeling of something that really happened. It did, but the poetic license he takes in the fictionalizing of it adds drama without detracting from the events themselves, which have been documented elsewhere.

Can we ever know what our fellow human beings are really thinking and what their motivations are? Or do we only appear as "the lighted side of a shadow" to others, who must guess at what the reality is? In "The Soul Murderer" a gruesome murder occurs, and the need to find the answers changes the lives of many people. This is a work of fiction but it is based on a real incident.
