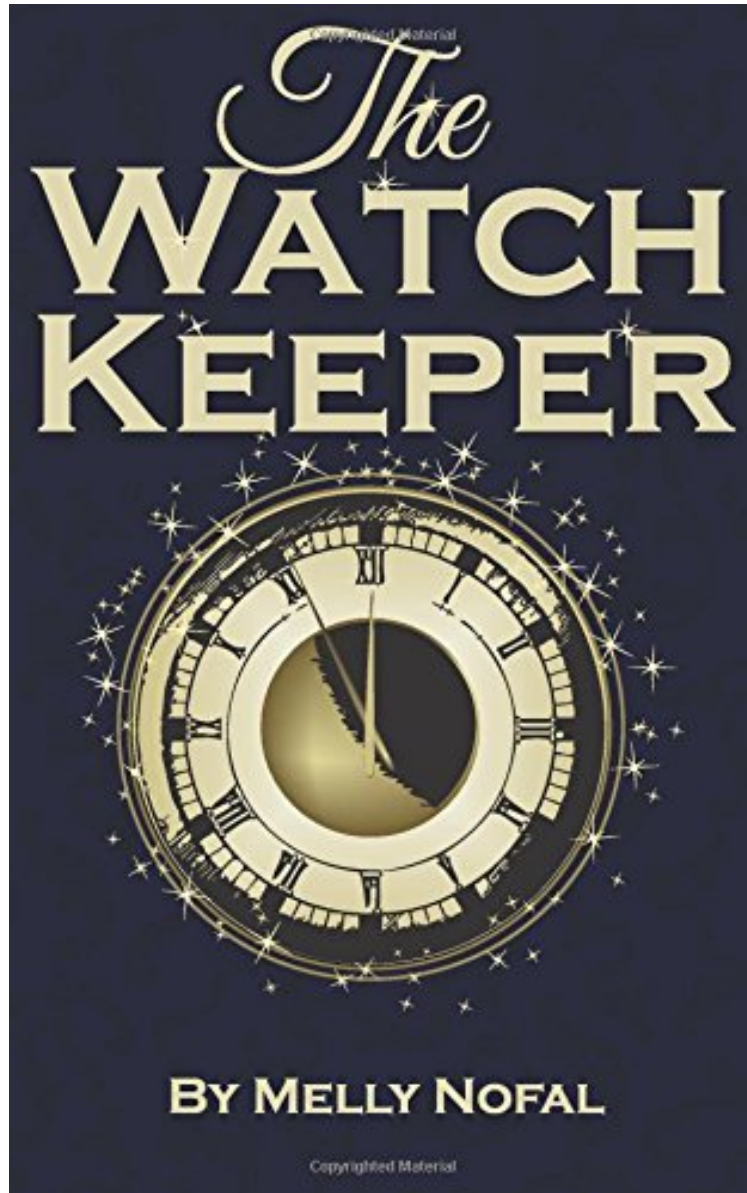

At the beginning of the book, there is a quick introduction that the experienced and novice collectors, alike, will appreciate, as well as suggestions on how best to catalog your collection. What I like the most is the sample entry provided to give each collector an idea of what to record and how to personalize each notation. This book made a great stocking stuffer for my husband this past holiday season, because one of the reasons I married him, besides being handsome, funny, intelligent, kind, blah, blah, blah, was because we encourage each other to feed our natural (or unnatural) mania for all things watch related.
