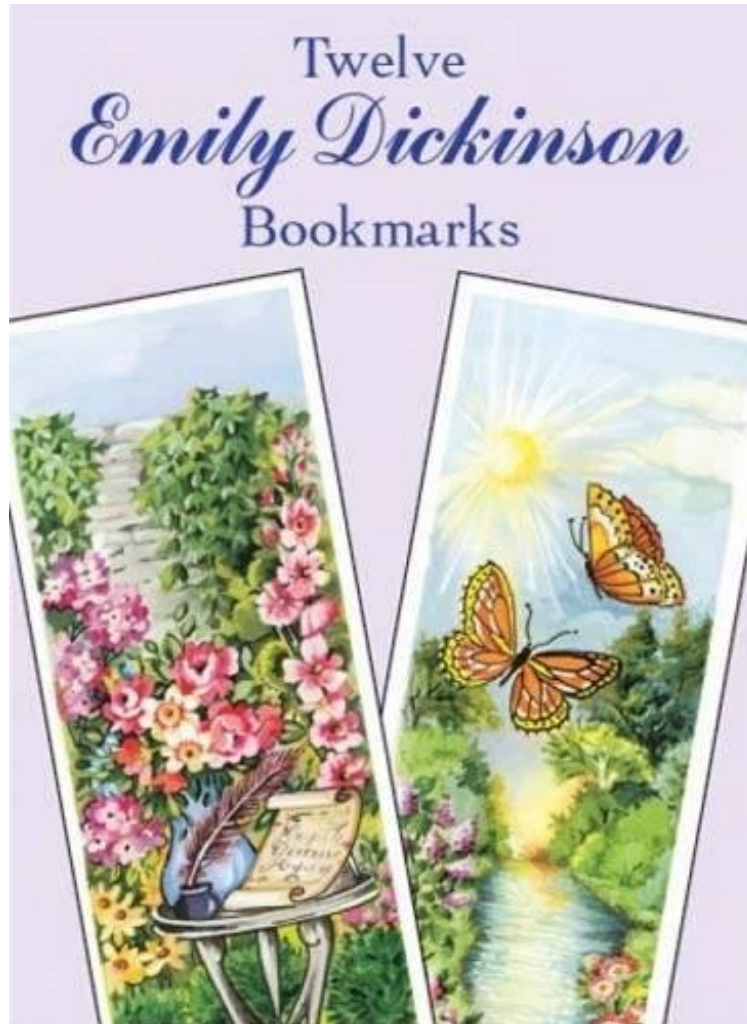

The print and pictures are colorful and I like them. The size of the bookmarks is perfect as they are useful for small books too. They come together as a book and are attached with each other with perforation which comes out very neat. Recommend this item to all real book readers. Can be a good gift for someone who likes to read books.

Each bookmark features one of Dickinson's best-loved short poems and an exquisite watercolor illustration on the reverse side. Each bookmark is 2" x 5¾". Twelve poems in all, including "I'm nobody!
