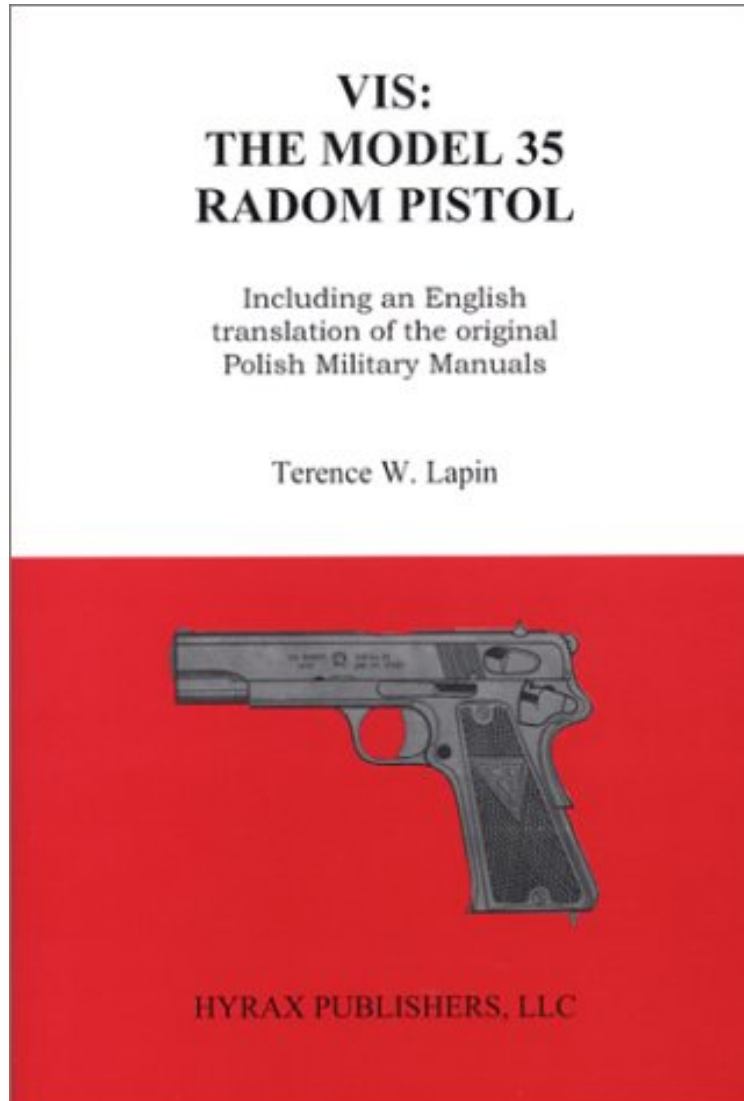

If you need one of these manuals, its perfectBy Andy in WashingtonI recently inherited a Radom, and wanted to rind a little more about it, and learn how to disassemble and clean the weapon.If you are in the same position, it almost doesn't matter what this review says, because this is the only source I could find for Radom information.Having said that, this book is actually pretty good.Most of the book is copies of technical manuals and documents for this weapon, and they are sufficiently detailed to allow you to strip and clean the weapon, and reassemble it. I am not a gunsmith, and am not sure if the drawings were detailed enough to

allow for more serious repairs or modifications, but the exploded diagrams seemed pretty thorough to me. There is a minimum of narrative, although the history and background of the weapon is described pretty well. There is also information to allow you to determine some of the history of any particular weapon based on markings. In short, if you have a Radom, I'd recommend this book.
