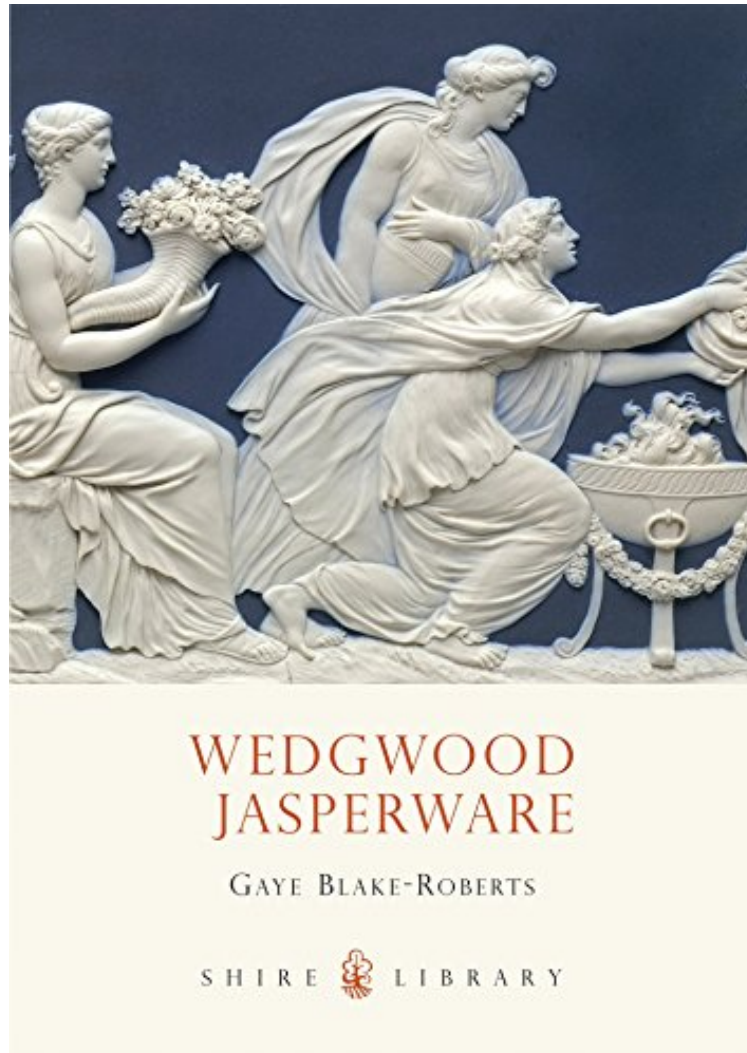

It has been by far the most widely collected of all Wedgwood products, and this book will explore the history and stories behind this unique ware.
