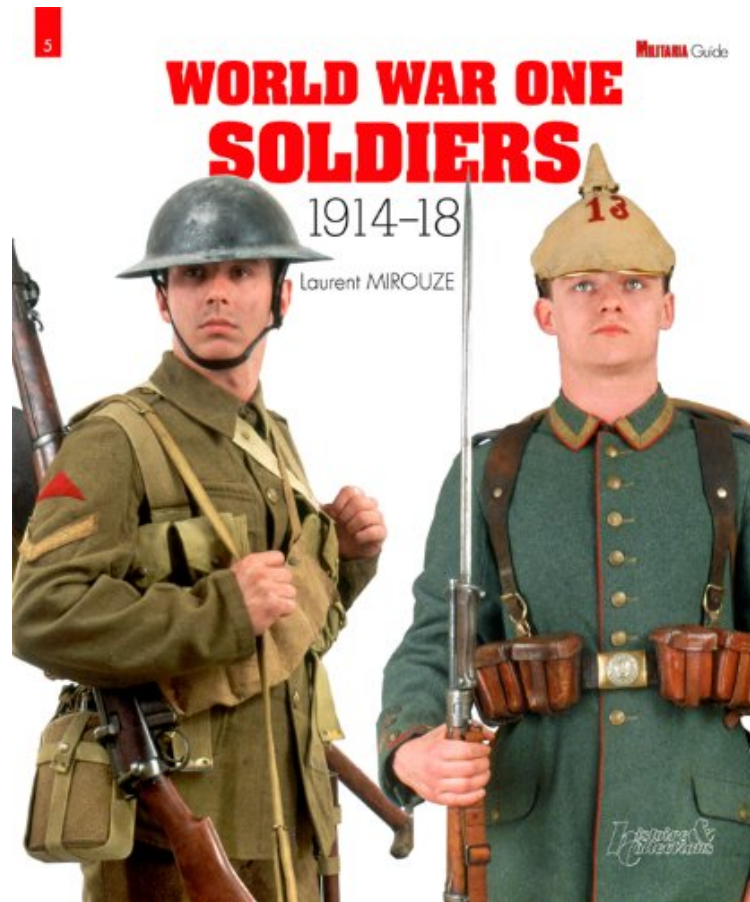

If the description of the book had been accurate I would not have purchased it. First, it was listed as a hardback...its not, its softcover! Second, the description on .Com as of this day says it is 84 pages, so I thought I was getting an additional 12 pages from the original. It is not, it is the same 66 pages as the original version.
